Our Ottawa Suzuki Strings summer camp is **open to any Suzuki student ages 4 – 13.**

Every day, your child will share in 3 – 4 hours of music making with Ottawa Suzuki Strings faculty.

Beginner Program – Introduction to Strings

- Open to new students not currently enrolled in a Suzuki program, ages 4 – 8
- Introduction to violin, viola, cello, or guitar
- Instruments will be provided
- Daily choir

Program for current Suzuki students

- Group classes
- Mini lessons (in a master class setting)
- Ensembles
- Daily choir

Snack and Lunch

- Daily nutritious snack will be provided
- Students must bring their own lunches
- Friday pizza lunch will be provided

In addition to faculty members and instructors, a team of counsellors will be on site to ensure the comfort and safety of the children.

Additional activities/events during the week include:

- Non-music classes (e.g. drama, arts and crafts)
- Outdoor games and sports
- Outdoor water games
- End of week performance open to family and friends

The camp will be held at Kanata United Church located at 33 Leacock Drive, Kanata.

The camp will run daily from 9 am – 4 pm (5 pm on Friday).

Pre- and post-camp care will be available for a small fee. Every effort will be made to organize carpools for families coming from the east end.
